Secondly, It has been reported that the AAJVS Motor Cycle (Hero Honda splendor) under the disposal of Shri. G. Venkat Rao, Peon-Cum-Chowkidar, Onge Settlement, South Bay was used by some un-authorized personnel at Little Andaman. This Motor Cycle is a property of AAJVS and is supposed to be utilized properly for implementing the welfare programmes of the Onges, which was not followed as reported.

Further, as per the records available with this AAJVS Office, Shri. Ramnath Singh was the only employee of AAJVS present along with the Onges at 16 KM relief camp ~~even~~ after earth quake and Tsunami. All other employees viz.. Shri. V. Palaiyan and G. Bhaskar Rao, were reportedly absent from the relief camps. Shri. G. Venkat Rao and G. Bhaskar Rao left Hut Bay immediately after earthquake and Tsunami leaving all Onges at their own fate.

Henceforth, Shri. Bisweswar Das, Social Worker (HQ), AAJVS, who has been deputed for the relief and rehabilitation of the Onges is directed to verify and confirm the receipt of relief materials sent from Port Blair and Hut Bay areas and inform whether proper disbursement was made to the Onges. He should submit <sup>an</sup> detailed report <sup>of</sup> with respect to receipt and disbursement of all item-wise materials supplied and issued to Onges of Little Andaman. He is also directed to inquire about the attendance of AAJVS employees from 26.12.2004 to 31.1.2005 and submit a detailed factual report to this Office for necessary action. A detailed report on the misuse of AAJVS Motor Cycle should also be submitted to the undersigned.
