

at his aunt's house site situated at School Line from 02.00 pm till I was picked up by the police at about 02.45 pm. The necessity of the visit to the house of Shri Kishen Singh's aunt is further explained in the statement of Shri Kishen Singh and also supported by the Defence Documents 1 and 2 mentioned above.

Conclusion:-

The analysis of the evidence on record and its assessment as has been made in the foregoing paragraphs brings out the fact that I never visited Smti MV Jayalakshmi, the complainant at her residential quarter No.174/3 at Minnie Bay as alleged in her complaint as well as the charge sheet. During the inquiry the prosecution could not bring home any substantial record or fact sustained by evidence of any sort to prove the charge as leveled against me. In the light of the facts as discussed herein above there is no evidence on record to prove the charge framed by the Disciplinary Authority against me and, therefore, I am liable to be exonerated.

I, therefore, make a plea for my exoneration based on the evidence on record of this inquiry.
