- 30. It is submitted that the Writ Petitioner fail to make out any case which require interference by this Hon'ble Court. Hence the Writ application is liable to be rejected. Hence the petition is not made in good faith. The order issued by the Disciplinary Authority is well within the powers conferred under the rules and therefore, the Write Petition filed by the petitioner has hardly any merit.
- 31. That the statements made in paragraphs No.1 to 30 of the Affidavit in Opposition are true to the best of my knowledge, based on record and belief and information.
