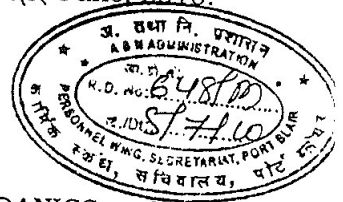

**ORDER**

Whereas Shri Govind Ram, Entry Grade officer of DANICS and the then Assistant Commissioner, Tribal Welfare Department and Executive Secretary, AAJVS was placed under suspension with effect from 16<sup>th</sup> October, 2008 in terms of sub-rule (1) of Rule 10 read with sub-rule (2) of Rule 13 of the CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 by the Chief Secretary, Andaman & Nicobar Islands Administration's order No.3798 dated 16<sup>th</sup> October, 2008 for the following reasons:-

- (i) That he allegedly molested one Smt. M.V. Jayalakshmi w/o Shri R. Vasantha Kumar, House No. 174/3, Minnie Bay in her house and was also arrested by the police in FIR No. 835 dated 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2008 under section 342/354 IPC at P.S. Aberdeen filed on the complaint of Smt. M.V. Jayalakshmi;
- (ii) That he indulged in the alleged crime during the time when he should have been attending his official duties;
- (iii) That he failed to intimate about arrest.

2. And whereas the nature of the misdemeanor leveled against the said Shri Govind Ram, is of an extremely grave nature and the charge sheet bearing No. CS No. 901/08 has been issued. The said criminal case is pending trial in the Hon'ble Court. Besides, disciplinary proceedings under Rule 14 of the CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 against him have also been instituted on 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2009. The Inquiring Authority completed the inquiry. As per the findings of the inquiry report, the charges framed against Shri Govind Ram could not be proved. However, the Disciplinary Authority, vide order dated 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2010, remitted the case to
