

103 May kindly see the minutes of Director (TW),  
A&N Administration at para 91 to 97/ante please.

104 The tenure of Police Radio Operator posted at Strait  
Island is for a period of three months. He is posted on  
duty-cum-tour only. It will not be convenient to assign  
the task of handling cash of AAJVS by the Police  
personnel. Yes, It will lead to blocking of funds. Further  
we would be giving a scope of embezzlement if the funds  
are provided to the Police personnel. No, the Police  
Radio does not have the minimum infrastructure for  
keeping hard cash.

105 A full time Social Worker or alternative employee is  
needed to be posted at Strait Island. If he stays  
regularly, then the entire issue can be sorted out and  
the execution of various welfare activities can be done  
perfectly with a logical end.

106 The cash allowance is drawn and paid to the Social  
Worker on the last working day of every month. It is the  
responsibility to the Social Worker to disburse the cash  
by sailing in the first available boat to Strait Island.

107 The Social Worker maintains the attendance and  
supervises the work when he is a station. He prepares  
the muster roll and disburses the wages. No, the Police  
radio Centre does not carry out all these tasks.

108 With reference to Para 95/ante, the alternative  
course of action vis-à-vis the minutes issued placed at  
page 18 to 19/C, it is to say that we may issue a formal  
order to the Social Worker in this regard.
