Sub: Incident with a female Jarawa (PTG) at Tirur - reg. Sir.

I am to enclose herewith a copy of letter no. SP (D/SA)/2010/7054 dated 5/10/2010 received from Superintendent of Police, Andaman District regarding the above subject matter and to state that Shri Narayan Roy alice Sujai S/o. Shri Khokan Roy(25) years R/o. Herbattabad involved in the above said case 192/10 dated 25th Sept. 2010 has been booked U/S 323/504 IPC r.w.s. 3(i)(x) SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989. The provisions of section 7/8 of the PAT regulation may also have to been imposed on the accused to make the punishment more stringed.

In this connection it is to mention here that AAJVS and the Andaman & Nicobar Administration is mandated towards the protection and safety of particularly vulnerable tribes. The notified Jarawa Policy has been formulated for this particular purpose. The atrocities Act 1989 and PAT regulations need to be invoked to safeguard the interest of the tribes. So as to minimize outside intervention and instruction into their reserved territory.

It is therefore requested to kindly direct to your Officers to book offenders and intenders under the provisions of both the Acts.
