Sub:- Report on grievance of six person of Jirkatang No. 2- reg. Baseless

Kindly refer office memorandum dated 07/12/2010 I would like to submit a detailed and a factual report on the issue as mentioned in the letter dated nil from the six persons (land owner) of Jirkatang No. 2. I would like to submit the report on point and para wise.

- i. There was no trees passing of Jarawa into the plantation area on 02/12/2010 as mentioned in the memorandum.
- ii. I would like to clear that no Jarawa were present in the ATR area (Jirkatang to M/s) since 26/11/2010 to till date.
- iii. It is not clear from the joint grievances submitted by the six persons of Jirkatang area that which month the Jarawas damaged and destructed the plantation area? However, some bananas were taken by the Jarawa from the plantation of Shri. C. Moideen during the month of October, 2010. After receiving the complaint from Shri. C. Moideen, the Jarawas were motivated and instructed by the field staff not to enter into the plantation of non tribal. Subsequently it was materialized by the efforts of field staff of the area.
- iv. No complaints was received from all the five landowner except Shri. C. Moideen regarding damaging the plantation by Jarawa since last August, 2010. In fact all the five land owners are residing at Naya Puram and nobody is at Jirkatang to look after their plantation, in such situations it is very difficult to say any degree of reliability that the damages was made by the Jarawas only, if any.
- v. The statement mentioned in the letter that the officials of AAJVS are quite often found in the interior part of the reserve forest between Jirkatang No. 2 to Middle strait is totally baseless, the AAJVS field staff are very much
