performed their duty at the ATR in the different locations not into the interior part of reserve forest.

- vi. It is mentioned that the Jarawas are mostly camping in 5 locations on the ATR in 9 Km, Punnanala, Potatang, Bidinala and R.K. Nala the nearest Jarawa location is at 9 km from JPP Jirkatang, if the Jarawas wants to invade the plantation area (as reported) they have to walk upto 7 km which is seems not to be possible during day time.
- vii. Self enquire the matter on field on 11/12/2010 and found nobody is in the plantation. Moreover, self managed to interview the younger son of Shri. C. Moideen and the fact reveals staff that they want a full time filled of AAJVS to restrict these Jarawas from entering the plantation, in other word to take care of their plantation. He further requested to engage / appoint one of his family member as filed staff of AAJVS to protect their plantation in future. This is submitted please.
