Superintendent of Police, Middle Andaman on 05.10.2010 regarding incident with a female Jarawa tribes at Tirur area.</p> <p>(5)</p> <p>The Dy. Superintendent of Police, Middle Andaman has informed that a case Cr. No. 192/10 dated 25/09/2010 U/s 325/504 IPC r.w.s. 3(1) (x) SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989 has been registered at Police Station, Ograbraj on the written complaint of Shri Raj Kumar Kongari S/o Late Ishak Kongari (32), Field Attendant, AAJVS, Tirur No.1 (A). The detailed report given as under:</p> <p>(6)</p> <p>The matter was reported to the I/C OP Tirur, ASI by Shri Rajkumar AAJVS staff on 25.09.2010, they was immediately deputed one Police constable with two employees of AAJVS namely Shri Anbukarasan and Shri Rajkumar, field attendant, they went to Jarawa Chadda at old Tirur No.4 where they found Jarawa lady, Baliwaye. She was injured, narrated them the entire incident stating therein that on 24/09/10 at 1130 hours, she alongwith 03 other Jarawa ladies, namely, Anijay, Manji and Ethaji were returning to their hut at Tirur no. 1A after fishing at Herbertabad. While they were walking on the "Bandh" in the paddy field in above mentioned area, one person Sujai of Herbertabad village abused them in filthy language. When Jarawa ladies asked him as to why he was abusing, he threw a balli towards them, due to she was injured on her left arm.</p> <p>(7)</p> <p>Thereafter, AAJVS staff brought the injured Jarawa lady, to PHC. Tushnabad for further treatment. After admission SHO. Ograbraj enquired the matter with the injured Jarawa.</p> <p>(8)</p> |
