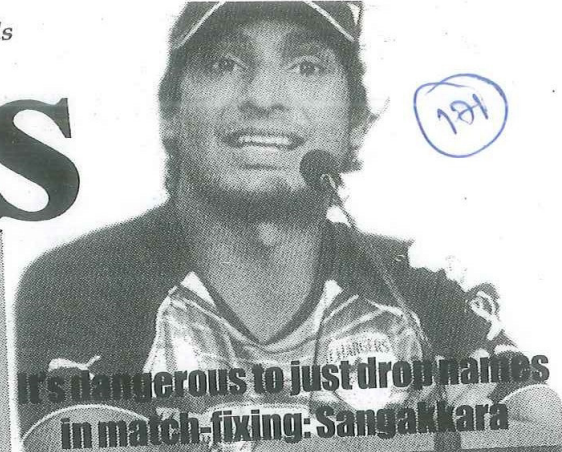

Drivers, vehicle owners cautioned against interacting with tribals on ATR

Port Blair, May 2

The Administration has cautioned the drivers and owners of all vehicles operating on ATR against stopping of their vehicles between Jirkatang and Middle Strait on the pretext of breakdown or some other reasons and interact with the tribals. The caution comes in the wake of reports of such instances noticed by the

Tribal Welfare Authorities here. A decision was taken recently in the State Transport Authority Meeting on the matter relating to the vehicles crossing between Jirkatang and Middle strait and it was decided to book cases against the offenders who stop their vehicles on such pretext. Such vehicle owners are

advised that strict instruction may be given to the drivers of the vehicles not to stop anywhere in between these two points and interact with the Jarawas. The Director (TW) said in a communication here today that separate instruction has been given by the Department to the staff of AAJVS posted on ATR to note down the

details of such vehicles who intentionally stop their vehicles so as to take action against such offenders which includes suspension of the permit. In view of this decision, the drivers of the vehicles and the owners are warned not to indulge in interacting with the Jarawas on the ATR, a communication received here said.
