Dr. Das talked with the Incharge of Tirur regarding allotment of one vacant quarter, Type -I out of four. He agreed to allow Shri. Yadav to accommodate the quarter subject to permission of Dy. S.P or S.P. Hence, he has requested for talking up the matter with Dy. SP / SP to shoot out the problem.

In this connection it is to mention here that transfer and posting of AAJVS employees from one settlement to another is a normal phenomenon. AAJVS does not have a camp / office at Tirur. A proposal was placed before the last meeting of Executive Council during August 2010 for allotment of land at Tirur / Herbertabad for establishing Office at Tirur, it was resolved that:-
