The Board desired that strict vigil should be maintained to check poaching of this animal which is the primary food source for the Jarawa tribes.</p>	<p>(Report from Police/AAJVS) is awaited.</p>
4.1	<p>PA Network- Revised report of WII, based on the recommendation of the sub-committee of the SBWL. <i>Action- Forest Dept.</i></p>	<p>The Chief Wildlife Warden apprised the Board on action taken on this matter. The Board desired that the proposal for clustering of existing Sanctuaries and National Parks approved during the last Board meeting should be put up early by Forest Department for Govt. approval. The Chairman emphasized that the proposal for clustering should be accompanied by proper mapping. He also asked the department to submit a proposal regarding realistic assessment of Protected Area. The Board also suggested to constitute a local committee to strengthen protection mechanism of the existing Sanctuary/National Park</p>	<p>Inclusion of 3 small North, Middle & South Button Island on the North west of Rani Jhansi Marine National Park and the intervening sea area in the RJMNP duster being critical for Dugong and sea grass bed is processed. Further, information on this matter like GPS points showing latitude & longitude, area, map are to be included in this proposal for which Divisional Forest Officer, Havelock has been asked to do so.</p>
4.6	<p>Forest Out post/coastal security/ greater involvement of Forest Officers who are already posted in remote locations including Tillongchang – (Proponent - Coast Guard) <i>Action- Forest Dept./Police Dept.</i></p>	<p>The Chief Wildlife Warden apprised that Police Department is opening a Look-out Post for which a barrack accommodation for ten police personnel is being constructed. The Board desired that a forest camp should also be established in Tillangchong side by side with LOP to check poaching of marine life. The Chairman desired that pre-fabricated materials could be used for construction of barrack/camps instead of concrete based construction.</p>	<p>Establishment of Forest camp at Tillangchong island is under consideration.</p>
