(i) In exercise of the power conferred under Section 60 A (2) of the Act, the Lt. Governor of Andaman & Nicobar Islands empowers in respect of case compounded under section 54, the Officer compounding to order payments of reward to a person who renders assistance in the detection of the offence or the apprehension of the offenders out of the sum of money accepted by way of composition not exceeding fifty percent of such money.

Rationalization and modification of the boundaries of Galathea Wildlife Sanctuary

After major earthquake on 26-12-2004 most part of the Galathea Wildlife Sanctuary is submerged in sea. Due to major changes in topography the turtle nesting has shifted towards north in the mouth of river Galathea. Therefore it is proposed to extend the boundary of Protected Area towards North by including the new beaches and intervening sea of the earlier boundary.

Consolidation of the Boundary of Lohabarrack Crocodile Sanctuary

The notified area of Lohabarrack Crocodile Sanctuary is 100 sq. km, whereas the actual as noticed during preparation of Management Plan of the Sanctuary is noticed that the delineation of boundary reveals that the area of Sanctuary is around 21.57 sq. km. This discrepancy need to be corrected and further step for revised notification is to be issued. Thus the proposal is submitted before the board for consideration.

Installation of Coastal Surveillance Network at East Island

To strengthen the coastal security of these islands, a proposal for installation of RADAR station on steel tower within Directorate General of Light House & Light Ships premises at East Island over an area of 0.008 ha has been submitted by Comdr. Coast Guard, A&N Region. As the entire island is wildlife sanctuary, the proposal needs clearance under Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972. Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Division, Mayabunder has submitted his site inspection report and recommended for the proposal.
