Tobacco and tobacco related products are intoxicants and thus attracts provision contained under section 7 of The Andaman & Nicobar islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Regulation 2012.

Therefore, considering the above, all employees of AAJVS are hereby directed that:-

- They will not consume tobacco or tobacco related products either in tribal settlement or in Office / office premises
- They will not carry these products with them either in their pocket, bag or vehicles, ~~while they are on duty~~ *then*

These directions shall be strictly complied by each and every employee of AAJVS without fail. Surprise check / verification shall be conducted from time-to-time. Offenders shall not be spared. Violation of the above direction will be ~~viewed seriously~~ *it attracts disciplinary proceeding*.
