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(155) This is a letter received from the S.P. South Andaman address to the Secretary (TW) A & N Administration dated 27th Jan 2011 regarding absence of AAJSVS employee at Puna Mallah, Jarawa Reserve area.

(156) He has informed that on 3/6/11 at 9.30 hrs. a convoy of trucks had left from M/Strait to J/Tang, when the convoy reached near Puna Mallah, few Jarawas (15-20) stopped the convoy and tried to get into the trucks, however Police Constable did not allow the Jarawas. As such the Jarawas got annoyed and threatened the constable to attack with arrows, where there was no AAJSVS staff present near Puna Mallah and due to this reason, the Jarawas are stopping the convoy frequently.

(157) In this regard the Director (TW) has desired a detailed note of the absence of AAJSVS staff on the date of incident at Puna Mallah from Dr. B. Das. According a draft memo added for
