This is a letter sent by Ms. Sophie Grig, Senior Campaigner, Survival International, United Kingdom address to Shri Ajay Saxena, IFS, CCF (WL) Commissioner -cum -Secretary (TW) regarding welfare of Jarawa tribes.

She has informed that the principle of 'minimum intervention' should be strengthened. Further stated that the AAJVS staffs sometime give the Jarawa food, clothing, tools and other goods this practice risks generating dependency. The Jarawa Policy's stipulated that medical treatment should be provided inside the Jarawa reserve, except in exceptional circumstances, and should also be adhered to.

She has stated that the Jarawa Policy's Principles of maximum autonomy and minimum intervention are fully implemented and Jarawa's land and resources are protected.

She has stated that she can be any assistant in these welfare matter.
