REPORT

This report is in connection with discriminatory attitude shown by the Shri. Khan, in-charge, Jarawa Protection Post, Jirkatang, towards AAJVS staff.

ES AAJVS while on tour to Middle Strait on 2nd May 2010 caught a private Motor Cycle at Potatang being plied by a relative of Shri. Raghu Head Constable no: 577. Shri. Raghu is posted at Middle Strait. An official complaint was lodged with the Superintendent of Police vide letter no: 10-106/2009-TW/297 dated 5th May 2010. Copy of letter is enclosed.

Dr. Blsweswar Das, Social Worker, AAJVS, posted at Jhinga Nallah, informed ES over phone that Shri. Raghu has been transferred from Middle Strait. Due to this incident, Shri. Khan, in-charge, Jarawa Protection Post, Jirkatang is not allowing AAJVS staff posted on ATR to perform their duties with their two wheelers. He had prevented Shri. K. Papa Rao, Peon-cum-Messenger, AAJVS to take his vehicle beyond Jirkatang with the comments that:-

"your ES had made a complain to SP and our staff has been transferred, no AAJVS staff will go inside ATR with motorcycles".

In this connection it is to mention here that AAJVS staff posted on ATR have to reach their duty point before the convoy starts so as to prevent unwarranted contacts with the Jarawas. For this purpose AAJVS staff uses their own two wheelers. Depending on the bus to reach their destination will delay the process.
