You were one of the members of the multidisciplinary Composite Teams to study the Jarawas set up in pursuance of the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Kolkata in the W.P.No.48 of 1999. The Expert Committee appointed by Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India in pursuance of the Order of the High Court of Kolkata in the above said case is required to submit the report to the High Court on the basis of the study conducted by the Composite Groups.

Further to built up the documentary evidence indicating the progress made by the teams in carrying out of the research each Member of the Group was requested to send the weekly progress report from the field through their Co-coordinator. The Proforma for the weekly progress report were provided to you before you proceeded to the field.
