With reference to your office letter no. PS/OB/2018/2412 and No.2428 dt. 23/07/2018 and 25/07/2018 respectively pertaining of produce the thirteen / Fourteen Jarawa witnesses of Tirur area before the Hon'ble court to be fixed for examination on 23/08/2018 at Primary Health Center Tushnabad (copy enclosed for ready reference).


In this connection I would like to inform you that most of the Jarawa fellow members were already moved /shifted their camp in the western coastal area of South Andaman (Heeran Tikery, Badabalu and Bamboo Nallha) during the last week of July and some are first week of August 2018.

It is worth to mention here that the Jarawa members who are enlisted on the witness list were also accompanied with their family/group.

In this connection it is to submit here that the date for sitting of the Hon'ble court at Primary Health Center Tushnabad i.e 23/08/2018 may kindly be differ for another date keeping in view the seasonal movement of the Tribal people, as at the present juncture it is not feasible to produce the enlisted Jarawa witnesses before the Hon'ble court on the stipulated date and time because of inclement weather condition (strong wind and rough sea).
