May please refer to the decision taken in the meeting held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary in ANTRI on 17/11/2017 vide para 2-5 of the minutes at page 196-197/c. A workshop is scheduled to be organized in February 2018 to discuss and take stock of welfare measures among PVTGs for which a set of issues are to be identified and flagged.

Further, may also see the suggestion made in the joint report recorded by Director (ANTRI), DD(TH), ES (AAJVS) in the AAJVS File in the context of snake-bite case of the Jarawa boy in November 2017 (page /c) wherein a Workshop-cum-Training on emergency medical care delivery in the field /PHC level has been recommended.

In the above two context, if approved a "Workshop -cum- Training on Emergency Medical Care Delivery and Welfare for Aboriginal Tribes in the Remote Areas" could be held in ANTRI on 13/12/2017 in collaboration with Health Department, Medical College (ANIIMS), AYUSH, AAJVS and Tribal Welfare.

The Medical Officers from PHC, Kadamtala, Ferrargunj, Tushnabad, R.K. Pur, Little Andaman, Campbell Bay could be deputed by DHS to attend the Workshop-cum-Training.

The Director, ANIIMS may depute the senior doctors from related Departments to participate in Workshop and impart training.

Deputy Director (TH) may coordinate for the participation of connected doctors in the Workshop-cum-Training.

ES AAJVS may call the field staff to attend the Workshop who will raise the issues/ problems related the welfare of PVTGs apart from getting to know about medical care. ES AAJVS may arrange food/snacks etc for the Workshop.

In the forenoon the issues of medical care for communicable and non-communicable diseases could be discussed by the senior faculties from the Community Medicine (Preventive & Social Medicine), Dermatology, Nutrition etc. Discussion of the problems faced by the field staff and suggestions could be other part of forenoon session. Every T.W.O will speak in the Workshop.

In the afternoon on 12/12/2017 the management of medical emergencies could be the focus of the Workshop-cum-Training.

The copy of the above note could be given to concerned officers for necessary action, if approved.
