- Similar, display of the posters and banners in the Andamanese settlement at Strait Island and Onge settlement at Dugong Creek shall be done by the Tribal Welfare Officers of the respective areas. Video and photo documentation shall be made by the concerned officials.

4. Fourth Week: **Growth Monitoring:**

- In collaboration with the Health Department measurement of growth and mapping of anemia of Andamanese tribal children shall be organized at Port Blair.
- The Tribal Welfare Officers of Dugong creek in association with the PHC, RK Pur, Little Andaman shall organize the measurement of growth and mapping of anemia of Onge tribal children at Dugong creek.

5. Fifth Week: **Complimentary Feeding:**

- Free ration items are supplied by the AAJVS (Agency for the Welfare of the PVTGs) to the Andamanese and Onges which include jaggery also. The coconut plantations have been raised by the Administration for the benefit of Andamanese and Onges. As such, the coconut are available in plenty for the tribals. It is also been found that the Onges and their children eat their first meal in the day in the late hours. Therefore, the snacks consisting of grated coconut and jiggery could be tried under the guidance of the field functionaries of the health departments. The above actions shall be carried out by the respective Tribal Welfare Officers.
