Shri. Nilanjan Khatua stated that museums across the world will celebrate the International Museum Day (IMD) on 18th May 2019 by organizing various events.

To celebrate IMD and to build the Museum more community oriented and mobile as well as to create a cultural hub (where creativity combines with Indigenous knowledge and where visitors can co-create & interact), the Zonal Anthropological Museum of AnSI, A & N Regional Centre is going to hold a tribal interaction programme, by organising "Draw & Colour Workshop" among tribal children of the Jarawa. Museum professionals will reach to the Tribal Areas of Kadamtala where the children along with their family members will assemble and take part in the Draw & Colour Workshop on **20th May 2019.** A photographic exhibition will also be displayed to encourage these indigenous people of A & N Islands to preserve their culture & art heritage.
