PUC is a Note dated 8.6.2013 enclosing an extract from the email received from Dr Vishvajith Pandya, Expert Member, AAJVS about two days workshop on 8^{th} & 9^{th} July, 2013 on establishment of Tribal Research Institute (TRI) under the Directorate of Tribal Welfare in Port Blair. He has proposed the following issues to be discussed in the proposed workshop to arrive at a consensus: -

1) Starting Research Institute and creating a systematic structure for implementation of the policy of welfare emerging from research on the lines of a "mission"

2) To follow up some important aspects in each of the tribal reserve areas and specific tribal group that need to be undertaken as priority and kept distinct from the day today operation.

 To start the Research Institute with a small group that meets every month or so and make sure that a minimum of two staff team start the various works on priority basis.

4) To appoint honorary position for a year who make sure that the work moves in right direction and the office AAJVS and particularly its staff is accountable.

5) The year long honorary position holder may not be essentially stationed at Port Blair but he could be frequently available to visit the worksite and meet the workers to oversee the progress.

6) To plan out what we need to do and how and why as far as Sentinelese are concerned.

7) A study trip to Dugong Creek at the end of the dedicate sessions

He has further suggested that individuals from Expert Groups and the Administration could be considered for participation, only only by his suggestions the workshop may be heldon 8th-9th July 2013 in Port Blair and the following members of Expert Groups namely -Dr Vishvajith Pandya, himself, Shri Kanchan Mukhapadya, Supdt, ASI, Kolkata, Shri Manish Chandi, AMET, Wandoor, Port Blair, Shri SA Awaradi, ex-Director (TW) now posted, NCT New Delhi, Shri SS Barrick, Anthropologist, AnSI Port Blair, Prof. Apivitha Abbi, Professor of Linguistic, JNU, New Delhi, Expert Member of AAJVS, Dr Sasi Kumar, HOD, AnSI, Port Blair may be invited to participate in the proposed workshop. As for the Administration, the following officers namely Secretary (TW), Director (TW), ES AAJVS, DCs & SPs of all three Districts including the field officials of AAJVS namely Dr Bisweshwar Das, DR PK Sarkar & Shri Anoop Kr Mondal, TWOs posted at different tribal areas may also be invited to participate in the workshop.
