187 This is a complaint received from Smti. Surmae, W/o Late Jirake regarding misbehavior by one Shri. Abdul Salam, Ex-Sub Inspector of Police, Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

188 Although the compliant is against a Primitive Tribal Group member but from the language of the letter it appears that it has been made by some one having some other intention. It may be stated here that recently a pseudonymous complaint by One Shri. Charan Jeet Singh, S/o Late H.B. Singh R/o Bhatu Basthi, South Andaman regarding unauthorized removal of sea sand from the shores of Strait Island and use of the same by one of the contractors in the buildings at Strait Island was also received. The matter is still under examination. This complaint seems to be related thereto. Hence, file is submitted for further directions / action.
