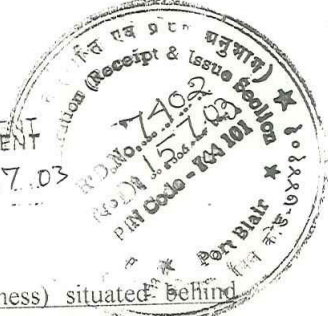

I am to inform you that the Nicobar Barracks(Mess) situated behind the Urban Health Centre Junglighat is in a very dilapidated condition and likely to be fallen down at any time especially during this monsoon season and life of the Nicovari and Govt. employees residing in the above said Barrack in a dangerous stage.

This matter has already been brought to the kind notice of the Administration by me several times and accordingly, the then Chief Secretary Shri Narayanswamy and Shri Padmanabhan visited the particular area during Municipal area inspections and inspected the dilapidated building during their time But it is a matter of great concern that no suitable steps have been taken so far to redress the intricate and difficult problem. If stringent steps is not taken by the APWD on war footing the case will lead to a very dangerous condition for which Councillor of Ward No.4, Municipal Council not be held responsible.
