I the undersigned bring before that light the mischief and threats details of Mr. ABDUL SALAM, (Ex-Sub- Inspector of Police, A & N Police)

On 05 July 2008 & on 8th September 2008, at about 11 A.M, Mr. Abdul Salam came in a Hyundai Gets registration No. AN01/D-3737 in a Adim Jan Jathi Viwab near Fire Brigade, very near to Vikas Bhawan and said, "hum jo hai Andaman Express news paper may delega bhik mangta hain, dandha karta hain, ye jo hai hum phele bhi Andaman Express paper my dala, aur bhi delega, tum log jo ukadna hain ukadlo", Surmai Queen of Strait Islands.

This is a serious offence committed by Mr. Abdul Salam (Ex- Sub Inspector of Police , A & N Police), as you all know that the Tribal is having the birth right of these Islands. For this act he should be booked under SC/ST atrocities Act 1956. He disobeys the sentiments of the ST.

This is a serious offence committed by Mr. Abdul Salam (Ex- Sub Inspector of Police, A & N Police), this will be actuating position of scheduled Tribe of these Islands. If this is not check the moral of the scheduled Tribe gone down.

That the Act has passed so long but the implementation of the Act is not so far. The people are not aware of the seriousness of the Act, if it so, by knowing the people are committing several offences under the said Act. Because people accused of the said offence are not sending behind the Bar, and the victims of this types of case were not holding proper knowledge and seriousness, and gravity of the offence, secondly the are shying people, fearing to come before the society and placing their grievances and problems.

That if proper action was not taken against the said culprit, I will personally appear before the competent authority and demand for the justice. And if strict action was not taken against the above named person, the matter may be referred to the Ministry of India, without any hesitation.
