Sea sand lifted from Tribal Reserve used for building construction

APWD Contractor cheats Great Andamanese and Government of India

Port Blair, June 20: Recently the Andaman PWD had conferred the construction work of 11 numbers of type III quarters for families of Great Andamanese Tribal Community in Strait Island to a private contractor. According to reports, APWD is supervising the construction work, which cost nearly 2 crores rupees. But, it has been learnt from reliable sources that the said contractor is using fresh stolen sea sand lifted from the shores of the tribal reserve island, to make huge profit. Obviously, the booty



would be shared with some officials of APWD and Forest Department, who are keeping their eyes closed in this matter. As per records the contractor didn't carry any quantity of 'Pulverized Sand' from Port Blair as per the agreement and allegedly in connivance of APWD, Forest, Tribal welfare staff (See... Page...02)

The MCA degree has also been recognized by AICTE as a technical qualification.

The development of the course structure for the BCA programme has kept in mind, the current trends of encouraging students at the Bachelors degree level to have exposure in some areas beyond their immediate specialization said Shri. S. Saunand. On the other hand MCA programme has been designed for developing skills in High End Computing with core courses such as Advanced Internet Technologies, Assembly Language Programme, Data Communication & Networking etc.

The broad objective of MCA & BCA is to prepare graduate students for productive careers in software industry, academia etc. The MCA programme is designed with a semester approach and the student will receive PGDCA certificate after successful completion of first year

Port Blair, June 20: Coast Guard Headquarters has declared Port Blair as selection centre for conduct of preliminary selection for the post of Assistant Commandant. Though direct recruitment into the Coast Guard started in 1979, however, due to poor response from these islands, sufficient candidates were not available, for declaring Port Blair as a centre for preliminary selection of offi-

recruitment for the officers is conducted every six months through advertisement in leading news-papers. The minimum educational qualification for applying for the post of an Assistant Commandant is Graduation in any discipline with Mathematics and Physics upto 12th standard and age group between 21 to 25 years with 05 years relaxation for SC/ST candidates and 3 years for OBC candidates.

complete application forms should be sent to reach on or before 11 Jul 2008 to The Director (MPR&T), Post Box No. 127, Noida (U.P.) - 201301. Under Postal Certificate (UPC) only. Registered letters & Speed Post will not be accepted. Eligible and short listed candidates will be issued call letters for PSB by 2nd week of August 2008. Candidates from Andaman & Nicobar Islands may fill choice of centre at Port Blair for preliminary selection.
