AAJVS was constituted as a registered Society under the Societies Registration Act, in1976 for the welfare of the primitive tribes. Since the inception of AAJVS, the primitive tribes mostly the Great Andamanese and Onge have been visiting Port Blair for various reasons like health, personal, during VIP visits, thorough out the year. For the better care and welfare, AAJVS had constructed a Guest-house (Adibasera) situated near the Port Blair Fire Station. The Adibasera has one dormitory which can accommodate 10 inmates at a time. It has a small store room and a type I watchman quarter.

The welfare activities and the over all development of the tribes have grown manifold over these years. The space available in Adibasera is in-sufficient to meet the present requirement of the stay of the primitive tribes. Presently there are 10 Great Andamanese and 2 Onge inmates at Adiabsera. Further the condition of the building, electrical wiring, wood works, kitchen etc is very bad and further renovation/repairs would not yield any fruitful result. Rather it will not cater the growing requirements for want of sufficient space.
