

Proceeding of the meeting held on 23rd May, 2018 at 10:00 AM in the chamber of Secretary (Industries), Andaman & Nicobar Administration to discuss and workout modalities for setting up of an exclusive display cum sales outlet on Tribal artifacts / locals products of Indigenous peoples in the Andaman & Nicobar Emporium, Sagarika.

At the outset the Secretary (Industries), Andaman & Nicobar Administration briefed about requirement of an exclusive display cum sales outlet of tribal handicrafts and artifacts to cater the need of the visiting tourists. As the Industries Department have a vacant covered space adjacent to ANE-Sagarika, Middle Point outlet which can be utilized to make it an exclusive tribal handicrafts /products display cum sales outlet. There after the detail modalities for setting up of an exclusive display cum sales outlet of tribal handicrafts and artifacts discussed in length and the action point emerged out of the meeting is as under :-

1. The existing covered space adjacent to ANE-Sagarika, Middle Point outlet will house display and sales of Tribal Handicrafts, Artifacts, Good of indigenous peoples of Andaman & Nicobar Islands besides goods from TRIFED and products of inmates of District Jail will also be displayed.
2. Tribal Handicrafts products to display with suitable write-up and story for the information of the visitors / customers.
3. AAJVS & ANTRI will provide write up on the local tribal products to be displayed on the wall in order to make the display more attractive and informative.
4. Paintings and graphics on Andaman & Nicobar tribal culture and crafts to be displayed.
5. Secretary (Industries) directed to motivate the tribal craftsman / artisans to bring their pottery products on display and sales.
6. Crafts of inmates of District jail to be displayed with writeup and photographs.
7. Items like fridge magnet to be arranged with tribal crafts printed on it.
