Relief to Fisherman


- For the fishermen who have been affected by the Tsunami waves as well as those who can't venture into the sea for fishing for where their houses have been flooded, the Relief Authority has decided to extend one month free ration to enable them to tide over the situation. This will be dispatched by the employees of the Directorate of fisheries in consultation with the Relief Authorities.

Funds for Relief on Natural Calamity

- The departments concerned shall incur expenditure under Major Head 2245 - Relief on Natural Calamity (Non-Plan), for which necessary provision will be made available.

Manpower for relief work

- To facilitate Rescue and Relief work DRMs may be engaged, on genuine need basis, for limited period of time.
