Great Andamanese are producing their traditional handicrafts presently staying in the Relief Camp at Adibasera, Port Blair. These handicrafts are proposed to be sold through the curio shop in the museum building of Anthropological Survey of India, Port Blair. The matter has been discussed with the Incharge of ASI, who has agreed to. The handicrafts can be sold through Cottage Industries Emporium of the Directorate of Industries also.

The sale proceeds of the handicrafts etc will go to the Andamanese. AAJVS and ASI will facilitate them in making the crafts and their sale. We may write to ASI and Director of Industries accordingly.

The handicrafts are to be priced appropriately taking into account various aspects. In this connection, officers connected with the sale of handicrafts could be associated. A Committee of such officials could be constituted to fix the price of the various handicrafts. The Committee may consists of the following:-

- (i) Director (TW).
- (ii) Head of Office, ASI, Port Blair.
- (iii) A.D.(handicrafts), Govt. of India, Port Blair.
- (iv) Senior Manager, Sagarika Emporium, Dte. of Industries.
- (v) Manager, Khadi & Gramodyog Board, Dte. of Industries.
- (vi) Executive Secretary, AAJVS, Port Blair.

If approved, the constitution of above said Committee could be issued. Draft order is placed opposite for perusal and approval.

Executive Secretary, AAJVS shall arrange to maintain proper Register and accounts of the production of handicrafts, makers of such crafts, sale proceeds and its disbursement to concerned Andamanese.
