This is regarding measures taken in connection with construction of Onge huts at Dugong Creek.

Executive Secretary, met Managing Director, ANIFPDC Ltd, Haddo, Port Blair today, ^{24th 6th June, 05} to discuss various issues relating to the above matter, with reference to a letter preferred by the General Manager, Copy placed at page 160-161/C. It was requested vide the above referred letter that ration articles, utensils, medicines, mosquito nets and medical facilities may be extended to the employees of ANIFPDC Ltd, who had been deployed at Dugong Creek for the construction of the Onge Hut.

During the meeting, it was decided that the ration articles and utensils required would be provide by Onges Multipurpose Cooperative Society Ltd, Dugong Creek and the bills would be raised on ANIFPDC Ltd for adjustment. Accommodation will be provided in the community hall at Dugong Creek, which has not been affected, by the Earthquake and Tsunami. Mosquito nets would be provided by AAJVS. With regards to medical coverage, due to practical difficulties, Medical Officer may not be able to reach Dugong Creek, therefore, the ANM posted at Dugong Creek would extend all medical assistance.

Regarding requirement of total quantity of sawn timber, the matter was discussed by the M.D over phone with the Deputy Manager, Hut Bay and the DM replied that within a weeks time, the full quantity of sawn timber required for the construction will be delivered at Hut Bay jetty point. OMPCS Ltd. would arrange for transportation of the sawn timber by using their own Engine Dinghy as informed by Social worker, etc who is the Treasurer of the Society and will be mailed to AAJVS.

Meanwhile, the Social Worker, Onge Settlement, Dugong Creek, informed that he would start the construction work within this week.
