Apart from the above, AAJVS has deployed two Group "D" employees viz.. S/s Debashish Mondal and K. Papa Rao, for one month from Port Blair to Dugong Creek to assist in construction of Onge huts and they left to Dugong Creek on 6.6.2005. One motorcycle, 10 plastic tarpaulin have been loaded on board MV Mus sailed to Hut Bay on 6.6.2005 at 2000 hrs. Four employees posted at Dugong Creek and two deputed have been provided with raincoats and jungle shoes so that they can discharge their duties un-interrupted during this rainy season and complete the work at the earliest.

Meanwhile, the Tehsildar, Little Andaman has been requested to provide one Motor Cycle out of the Tsunami account so that the same can be used at Hut Bay as the other two AAJVS bikes are used at R.K. Pur area, which is not practically possible between Hut Bay and R.K. Pur, due to bad road condition. He has also been requested to issue 400 litres of Kerosene oil for 2 portable generators provided by the A & N Administration to use at Dugong Creek during this construction work as well as in executing welfare programmes for the Onges.

It is to mention here that at Dugong Creek the Community Hall and two type 2 quarters are unaffected by Earthquake and Tsunami as reported by Social Worker, Dugong Creek during his stay at Port Blair and he further informed that all the above staff, workers and labourers will be provided accommodation accordingly. He further informed that many Onge huts have not been affected and can also be used, if needed.
