It is to mention here that free clothes for the Onges and Great Andamanese have been provided. The same has been distributed by the Social Worker, Onge Settlement Dugong Creek and Plantation-in-charge, Great Andamanese settlement Strait Island. Free clothes includes :


- a) Half pant for adult male = 2 nos.
b) Half sleeve shirt for adult male = 2 nos.
c) Blouse & ladies lungi for female = 2 nos.



Further it is to add here that Ramakrishna Mission Port Blair has provided ready made shirts for male Onges and frock to female Onge children. The same is available in Office and would be handed over to the Social Worker during his next ^{tour} to Port Blair. But this set of clothes does not include clothes for females as well as shirt for male and clothes for children

Therefore, as desired by the Special Secretary (TW) we may request the Nodal Officer, Relief (Haddo) to provide clothes for the Onges as detailed below:

- a) Adult male = 27
b) Adult female = 27
c) Male children = 25
d) Female children = 23
