Prior to the devastating Earthquake and Tsunami, the Onges were settled in two areas i.e South Bay and Dugong Creek. But after the disaster, all the Onges had been settled in a new safer location near Dugong Creek. The present population of Onges is 101. Basic facilities like traditional huts, medical sub-centre, powerhouse, drinking water supply, electricity supply, footpath etc has been extended to the Onges in their new camps. Onges were engaged on daily wages for extraction of jungle products to be used in construction of their traditional huts.
