It has been stated in your letter and the letter of the Dy.S.P.(HQ) that there are 2 vacant posts of Radio Technician and 8 posts of Constable (Driver). You have stated that for filling up of the above posts, no S.T.candidates are available with required technical qualification. While the Tribal Welfare Department is also undertaking suitable efforts to identify suitable candidates, you may kindly recall that in the Coordination meeting held on 10.1.2001 it has been stated by the Chief Secretary that the candidates with suitable educational qualification may be given adhoc appointment after getting relaxation of the technical qualification from the competent authority. Then the candidates should be given training in the required skill and after successful completion of the training, their services could be regularised.
