

## Agenda points for the Co-ordination meeting to be held on 10.01.2001.

Posts reserved for S.T. candidates are not filled up by the Departments due to lack of technically/educationally qualified S.T.candidates.

Enclosed is the statement showing the details of posts reserved for S.T.candidates, those filled up or lying vacant in different departments of the Administration. I have written to the HODs to give me the details of the posts under Group 'C' which are to be filled up by S.T. candidates and the educational & technical qualifications required for those posts. I had also asked the HODs to fill up all the Group 'D' posts lying vacant at the earliest. Some of the HODs have replied while the following have not:-

In case of Group 'C' posts which the departments are unable to fill up by S.T. candidates having requisite qualification, I would like to suggest the following:-

In case of posts like Vocational Instructor which is to be filled up in the Labour Deptt. the required qualification is 10<sup>th</sup> pass having a Craft Instructor Certificate. It has been suggested by the Labour Commissioner that one of the essential qualification i.e. having a Craft Instructor Certificate could be relaxed and filled up with a suitable candidate on adhoc basis, who would then be sent to an appropriate institute in the mainland to undergo this course so as to enable him/her to fulfil the academic qualification in accordance with the Recruitment Rules framed. I find the suggestion of the Labour Commissioner very appropriate and would suggest that the same procedure could be
