NOTIFICATION

No. 14/90 F..No. 1-22/87-Stat—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitutions read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. U.14039/2/83-ANL dated the 21st Feb. 1985 and in supersession of this Administration's Notification No. 106/77/F. No. 8-10/77-Stat dated 23rd May, 1977, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Senior Investigator/Assistant Statistic Officer borne in the establishment of Statistical Bureau of the Andaman & Nicobar Administration namely :—

namely :—

1. Short title and commencement :—
 - (i) These rules may be called the Andaman & Nicobar Administration (Senior Investigator/Assistant Statistical Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1989.
 - (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
2. Number of posts, Classification and scale of pay :—
The number of posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.
3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications
The method of recruitment, age limit and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said schedule.
4. Disqualifications :—No person—
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
 - (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post;

Provided that the Central Govt. may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
5. Power to relax :—Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
6. Saving :—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. from time to time in this regard.
