In exercise of the powers vested in him vide Govt.of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No.F.7/37/57-Estt(A) dated 14.12.1961, and on the recommendation of the Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi vide their letter No.F.1/420/91-R.I dated 5.12.1991, the Lt.Governor, (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands has been pleased to order, the appointment of Dr. Sher Singh Kashyota, (SC to the Group A post of Junior Medical Officer in the scale of R.2200-75-2800-EB-100-4000, in the A & N Health department, with effect from the date of assumption of duty in the post against the posts reserved for SC/ST candidates.

on regular basis subject to the following terms and condicion:

- (i) His appointment is purely on temporary basis
- (ii) He will be on probation for a period of 2 years.
- (iii) He shall not do any private practice of any kind whatsoever including laboratory and consultancy practice.
- (iv) He shall be eligible to Non Practicing Allowance at the rate admissible as per the orders of the Govt.of India. He shall also be entitled to Dearness Allowance, letin pecial compensatory allowance etc. as admissible under the orders in force from time to time.
 - (v) His appointment will be subject to:
 - a) Taking an oath of allegiance to the Constitution of India or making a solemn affirmation to that effect in the prescribed form.
 - b) Submission of declaration in the prescribed from regarding his marital status.
 - c) Being found medically fit and nothing being found adverse against him after verification of his character and antecedents.
 - d) If any declaration given or information furnished by him proves to be false of if he found to have wilfully supressed any material information, he will be liable to removal from service and such other a action as Govt. may deem necessary.
 - (v) Other conditions of service will be governed by the relevant rules and orders from time to time.
