Sub:- Filling of the vacancies reserved for ST in
the A&N Administration-reg.

Sir,
With reference to the meeting held on 3.4.2000
in the Conference Hall of the Secretariat on the above
subject, the details of pendency in filling up the re-
served posts are furnished as under:-

" There are 28 posts of Group 'C' in the Labour
Department and the appointing authority is the Labour
Commissioner and Director of Employment & Training.
There were 16 posts of vocational instructors in the
ITI till July 1999. Due to non-availability of qualified
technical personnel, at the time of inception of the ITI
in 1988/89, the reserved post at Roster Point-9 could
not be filled up with ST Candidate. All the ~~post~~
sanctioned posts have been filled up from General category
candidates.

Recently two posts of vocational instructors have
been created in July' 1999. As a result, the total no.
of posts of vocational instructors has risen from 16 to
18. The roster point at 17 is also to be filled up with
a ST candidate. It is stated that both the ST roster
points- 9 and 17 will be consumed by appointing qualified
ST candidates. The present delay in filling up the two
vacant posts was due to the review imposed by GOI for
economy in expenditure. Necessary clearance has been
obtained now from the Administration after the review of
the absolute necessity in filling up the vacant posts and
action is being taken up to fill up the vacant posts as
per the RRs by consuming the ST roster points."

action.
