Point No.14 and 15

(chapter III/Page No.259) : Any amendment to the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 has to be initiated by the Govt. of India since it is a Central Act.

No such incidence of reduction of working hours with pro rata cut in the daily wage has been reported in this territory.

The Minimum Wages has been fixed in the year 1997 for different grades of employees employed in the schedule employment. The Minimum wages for unskilled category has been fixed @ Rs.50/- per day for Andamans District and Rs.53/- per day has been fixed for Nicobar District. The removal of inequity in the statutory minimum wages will be considered as per provisions of Minimum Wages Act.
