II. Special Central Assistance

- (a) The details of allocation and expenditure in respect of SCA are furnished in Statement 1 and 2 of Annexure II (b).
- (b) There was major short-fall in expenditure during the year 94-95 due to non-implementation of schemes for Welfarcof Primitive Tribes. During the year 95-96 and 96-97 the short-fall in expenditure was negligible.
- III. Allecation of funds in SCP/TSP under various programmes for Rural Development.
- (a) The information in respect of the following schemes viz. JRY, MWS, IAY, EAS, IRDP, DWCRA and TRYSM have been furnished in statement 2 and 3. Other schemes mentioned in the list of agenda items are not being implemented in this U.T.
- (b) Ne evaluation studies of the Centrally Spencred Schemes have been carried out.
- IV. Review of Central/Centrally Spensered Schemes of Ministry of Welfare

The information in respect of Centrally Spensored Schemes viz. Pest-matric schelarship and Beek-Bank scheme have been furnished in the Statement 1 and 5.

V. Critical review of the Schemes under SCP/TSP and suggestions.

The information in respect of Item Nos.2, 3 and 4 are furnished in Statement 1 and 2 of Annexure, - 5, 6 and 3.

There are no Scheduled Castes in A&N Islands and hence there is ne Special Component Plan (SCP) in respect of this Union Territory.
