

4. Village and
S.S. Industries

- a) Supply of improved tools and spare parts of bullock carts & cycles to tribal beneficiaries. Improved tools supplied to 53 ST beneficiaries.
- b) Distribution of ratt and coir processing machinery to trainees on 50% subsidy.

5. Education

- a) Deputation of tribal girls students to Banasthali Vidhyapith, Rajasthan. 15 tribal girls students deputed to Banasthali Vidhyapith, Rajasthan.
- b) Supply of free uniforms to tribal students. Free uniforms were supplied to tribal students.
Free uniforms were also supplied to ST students at Strait Island and Dugong Creek.
- c) Supply of Mid-day meal to tribal students. Mid-day meals were supplied to ST Students.
- d) Supply of materials for sports and games in all schools of tribal areas. Sports and games materials were supplied to all schools in tribal areas.
- e) Opening of creches in tribal area in the vicinity of Islands and appointment on school mother.

6. Health

- a) To provide X-Ray films, medicines, equipments and furniture to sub-centres, PHCs, CHCs and District hospitals at tribal area. X-Ray films, medicines, equipment provided to Sub-centres, PHCs, CHCs and District Hospitals at tribal areas.
- b) To meet the cost of specialised treatment and investigation by periodical visit of Specialist and Doctors to Strait Island and Dugong Creek.

7. A.A.J.V.S

- a) Nelaferre of Shompen of Graet Nicobar. i) Free gift provided to Shompen towards subsidised cost under Exchange System.
- b) Welfare of Onges in Little Andaman. ii) The coconut plantation at Dugong creek and Strait Island were maintained for the benefit of tribals.
- c) Welfare of programme for the Andamanese. iii) The onges and Andamanese were provided free ration and clothing.
iv) The power house at Dugong Creek, South Bay and Strait Island were maintained.
v) Poultry farm with 100 layer birds established at Strait Island for the benefit of Andamanese maintained.
vi) The dispensaries at Dugong Creek, Strait Island and Shompen complex were maintained to provide medical facilities to tribals.
vii) 8 units of goats provided to Andamanese.
viii) An out board fitted engine dinghi supplied to the onges of Dugong creek for fishing was maintained.
ix) Two primary schools one each at Strait Island and Dugong Creek maintained.
x) The primer on Andamanese language completed by CIIL, Mysore.
xi) The primer on onge language has been completed by the CIIL, Mysore.
