This is with reference to the note No. SLG/REP/GP/Uttara/2001 dated 21st February'2001 from Secretary to L.G endorsing therein a copy of letter received from Pradhan, Gram Panchyat Uttara addressed to Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A & N Islands regarding public demands.

Pradhan, Gram Panchyat Uttara in the petition addressed to Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A & N Islands requested for construction of check post at Banyakhari to prevent entry of Jarawa at Uttara village. In this connection it is to report that the subject matter was discussed in the Task Force Committee (constituted by the Administration to advice for handling of Jarawa situation) meeting. Senior Officers from Police Department informed in the meeting that due to shortage of staff strength, a separate police outpost can not be constructed at Banyakhari and that to from where the police station is situated at a distance of 2 K.M only. However, police patrolling is intensify with the staff of AAJVS and village volunteers appointed in each village. Presently the incidents of Jarawa entering to settlement villages reduced.
