Madam,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. SLG/REP/GP-Uttara/2001/322 dated 21/02/2001 addressed among others to this office regarding the subject mentioned above. The detailed report on the point concerning Tribal Welfare Department is furnished as under :-

Pradhan, Gram Panchayat, Uttara in the petition addressed to Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, A&N Islands requested for construction of check post at Banyakhari to prevent entry of Jarawa into the Uttara village. In this connection it is to report that the subject matter was discussed in the Task Force Committee (constituted by the Administration to advice for handling Jarawa situation) meeting. Senior Officers from Police Department informed in the meeting that due to shortage of staff strength, a separate police outpost can not be constructed at Banyakhari and that to from where the police station is situated at a distance of 2 km. Only. However, police patrolling has been intensified with the staff of AAJVS and village volunteers have been appointed in each village. Presently the incidents of Jarawa entering to settlement villages has been reduced.
