Out of 33 streetlights (18 sodium vapour and 15 flourecent sets) fitted, only four (2 each type) are working and for repair of the other 29 sets, materials as per list are required. This matter was discussed with the Superintending Engineer (Elec) after my return from tour and as per Superintending Engineer (Elec) in case your Directorate agrees 16 sets sodium vapour lamps can be repaired by using materials available with this department and the charges for the same to be paid by your directorate.
