The AAJVS staff and expert members of AAJVS are sensitizing the tribe on this issue. The Admin is also taking strict penal action against the poachers.</p>	<p>The Research team engaged in empirical study submitted a report titled "Kangapo" (stitched garment in Jarawa language). The Kangapo project is being implemented under which stitched garments being provided to Jarawa ladies in exchange of their artifacts so as to avoid dependency.</p>
<p>2</p>	<p>Conflict of Interest between the settler population and Jarawas with regard to the Jarawa Tribal Reserve. Candidates during elections campaigned for a liberal tourism policy, relaxing buffer zones, expanding of ATR and bringing Jarawas into 'mainstream' (education, health, food doles- what some may call undignified dependence). Is this a battle of resources between the settler population where unemployment is high and the tribals who preserved the last patch of tropical rainforests in the Islands?</p> <p><i>Sensitization programme</i></p>	<p>The Tribal Welfare Department of the Administration including the ANTRI has taken up programme for sensitization of the settlers of the surrounding villages namely Collinpur, Herbatabad, Manpur, Templemyo and Turrur being sensitive in view of the frequent interactions and poaching by the settlers in the Jarawa Reserve area over the years.</p> <p>Over a period of 06 months, <del>no for</del> <sup>now</sup> four interactions have been held involving settlers and PRI representatives. Further a few individuals from the settlers community have been engaged as volunteers/informers by AAJVS to keep watch on intrusions/poaching by the settlers including movement of the Jarawas into the adjoining settlement villages and report to the Tribal Welfare Officer posted at Turrur whenever such incidents takes place. The outcome of such interaction has been very positive/encouraging in view of the fact that a few habitual offenders of the area could be apprehended/ nabbed and brought to book.
