

and Gilad (his left hand amputated) informed that one Dinghy man pronounced as Nitai by the Jarawas, took in his dinghy 5 Jarawas from Bambunallah area. These five Jarawas were ANITAMU (age 43), ILLY (25), ANTALI (27), ACHEHANE (25), and TAHE (22). As reported by the interrogated Jarawas that Shri Nitai took these five Jarawas in his dinghy and left them at Tarmugli Island (near Wandoor). Myself immediately reported this to the SHO, PS Ograbraj, the DySP attached to PS Barissooflat, and Director (Tribal Welfare). All the officers promptly responded actively with the individual effort and prompt cooperation by the DySP, SHO, Shri M. Sarvanan Sir attached to PS Hu phboy gunj and Shri Latif of PMF Wandoor a team has been constituted. All gathered at jetty Wandoor within one hour. The team comprised of myself, two AAJVS, Jarjati Sevak Shri. Papa Rao and Shri Bhaskar Rao, Shri Ranjith Sir, PMF Wandoor, Shri Latif, Shri M. Sarvanan Sir from PS Humphrey gunj, and two young PCs named Shri Salman Khan and Shri Sadique left Wandoor by an interceptor (high technology equipped boat) of PMF for Tarmugli Island. It was around 1700 (05-11-2013) hrs when we left for Tarmugli Island. Few hours ago a team of Forest Department, Wandoor conducted patrolling around the Tarmugli Island. A fisherman informed them about Jarawa sighting at Tarmugli Island. In the dark it was very difficult for us to see anything on edges of the Island. We made full effort to find any sign of presence of Jarawa or the fisherman if any with help of binocular and lights. Finally we returned back to Wandoor jetty at about 1830 hrs. The team dispersed at Wandoor jetty with the next plan. On the next day (today on 06-11-2013) a team comprised of AAJVS Jarjati Sevak namely Shri Navdeep Mondal and Shri Birman Dhali, Shri J. N. Halder HG 728 attached to TPP 4 Tirur, Shri Jaspal Singh PC 2103, Shri Prabhunath HC 816 attached to OP Tirur left from Collimpur Ghat and reached Tarmugli Island by AAJVS tendered engine dinghy at 1300 hrs. In the way from Old TPP 4 location (where few Jarawas were already camped) the team took a Jarawa man for assistance namely Kunu (age 26). On reaching the Island the team found the Police team and Forest team came from Wandoor. On seeing Kunu the said 5 Jarawas came in contact on shore. The team brought the said 5 boys to my office at Collimpur. The boys on soft interrogation told that - On 03-11-2013 evening one local dinghyman namely Nitai R/o. Guptapara, South Andaman reached chotagaja Jarawa camp (west coast). A Jarawa Reserve with some ration articles such as rice, veg oil, sugar, tea etc. He halted therefor that night with the Jarawas (men, women and children). On next day morning (04-11-13) he took two Jarawas namely Dawa and Iekthe to Bambunallah area where already few Jarawas were camped. They spent the day there. In the evening Shri Nitai Mondal took five Jarawas as mentioned above to Tarmugli Island. Shri Nitai Mondal did not stay with them in Tarmugli Island. He immediately left the Island. It is therefore requested to kindly take immediate action to punish the culprit to unleash a learning lesson for the others please.
