The proposal was approved by the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A & N Islands.

Accordingly, the notification was issued by the A & N Administration declaring the area upto five Km radius around the Jarawa Tribal Reserve notified 159/2004/ dated 15th September' 2004 from the Boundary Line starting from Constance Bay in South Andaman to Lewis Inlet Bay in Middle Andaman, as Buffer Zone. Any/person other than a member of an aboriginal tribe is prohibited from entering the Buffer Zone for any commercial and/or tourism activities. vide Notification No234/2007 dated 30/10/2007. (Copy enclosed). The notification was published in the Daily Telegrams' for information of the general public.
