

10. That in terms of the notification dated 26th August 2005 the word Chief Commissioner appearing in the Regulation of 1956 has been substituted by the word Administrator.

Copy of the notification dated 26th August 2005 is enclosed herewith and the same is marked as Annexure "A-2".

11. That the proposal as indicated in paras above was approved by the Hon'ble Lt. Governor with the specific instructions to ensure that no tourist resorts come up in the aforesaid zone, accordingly the notification was issued declaring the area upto 5 Km radius around the Jarawa Tribal Reserve area notified vide notification dated 15th September 2004 from the boundary line starting from Constance Bay in South Andaman to Lewis Inlet Bay in Middle Andaman as Buffer Zone and thus any person other than a member of an aboriginal tribe has been prohibited from entering the aforesaid zone for any commercial and or tourism activity vide notification dated 30.10.2007.

12. That the contents of para 1 is admitted to the extent that the petitioner is a private Ltd. Company and the rest of the contents of the aforesaid para is denied and disputed and the petitioner is put to the strict proof thereof in this regard. In this regard it is specifically disputed that Shri. Deepak Raj Govind is the Managing Director of the aforesaid company. It is further pertinent to mention that in para 1 Shri. Deepak Raj Govind has been stated to be the Managing Director, whereas in the affidavit his position has been stated to be that of the Director in any event no documents has been filed to indicate that Shri. Deepak Raj Govind is either the Director of the Managing Director of the company nor any authorisation and or
